

#### **MODERN SLAVERY & HUMAN TRAFFICKING POLICY**

#### 1. Introduction

TREECO LTD is committed to ensuring that modern slavery, human trafficking, and other forms of forced labour have no place in our business operations or supply chains. We recognize our responsibility to take a proactive stance in identifying, addressing, and preventing these unethical practices in line with the **Modern Slavery Act 2015**.

#### 2. Our Commitment

- Require all suppliers to confirm adherence to ethical labor practices as part of our supplier agreements.
- Assess potential risks in supply chains, especially in high-risk sectors or geographies.



# 5. Employee Awareness and Training

We are committed to raising awareness of modern slavery among our employees by:

- Providing regular training to help employees identify and respond to modern slavery risks.
- Ensuring employees are aware of reporting mechanisms to raise concerns.

# **6. Reporting Concerns**
